During these times, there will be no breakout sessions scheduled. The scheduled hours for display in Turner Hall will be on Friday, November 2nd from 12:00 PM to 4:30 PM. For this year set up will only be available the morning of November 2nd. Once presenters and topics have been secured for the conference, we will post the schedule on our website.
